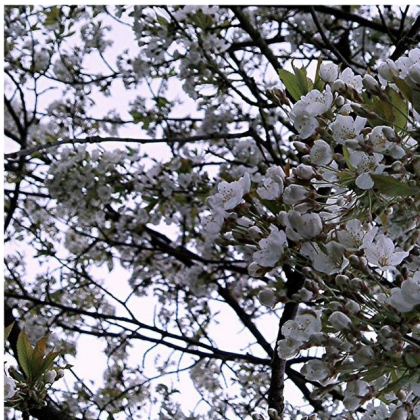


Whiteinch Community Council
Synopsis of Minutes of meeting held in the Conference Room at Whiteinch
Centre on Tuesday 31st March 2009.

- Regency Homes construction materials have reduced Squire Street to one lane. Concern was expressed that building has stopped. Cllr Colleran agreed to look into this matter.



- Gas Works – The phasing of the traffic lights at the tunnel has caused congestion problems on Dumbarton Road. Land Services will be contacted regarding this matter.
- Cycle Track Bridges are in a state of disrepair. Clarification was sought on the status of the Yoker Relief Road and if it includes any plans regarding these bridges



- Police Report - In March 33 crimes were reported and half of them have been detected. The figures included 3 housebreakings, 1 robbery and 1 break-in through an open kitchen window. Due the credit crunch the Police advised people to be very cautious at cash machines.
- Planning – Site at Ferryden Court for a Children’s Play Area – no objections. Victoria View, Westland Drive – no objections
- Householder Permitted Development Rights. This is a Scottish Government Document that is proposing changes to the current planning regulations. It was felt that this document needed more time for consultation.
